**What we want**

- Bio/Magazine Article 500 – 700 words
- Short Stories of 1,500 words. Genre is open – realistic or speculative, contemporary or historical, literary or commercial. As long as it has a strong plot, emotional appeal, and a connection to the theme, we want to read it!
- Poetry – Each individual poem must be no more than 1500 Words.



## What we DON'T want

- Erotica, rape scenes, or gratuitous violence, sex, violence, or profanity.

## Guidelines:

- **Who can submit?** Women and Men
- **Word Count:**
  - Bio/Magazine Article – 500 – 700 words
  - Short Stories: 1,500 words
  - Poems: 1500
- **Format:** Times New Roman, 12pt, double spaced, 1" margins, black text on white background. Include a header with the title and page number at the top of each page.
- **Multiple Submissions:** Up to three submissions will be accepted per author, but only one per submission form. If more than one of your submissions is accepted into the anthology, then it is up to the editors' discretion as to which is published. SIMA will only publish one story per anthology book.
- **Simultaneous Submissions:** We prefer that you do not submit your story elsewhere while we have it under consideration. If you have something perfect for SIMA's anthology that is submitted elsewhere, let us know. Alert us immediately if it is accepted by another publication.
- **Reprints:** We are looking for original, unpublished work only. Previously published work will not be accepted. This includes stories/poems/manuscripts published in any form on your behalf, personal or professional website.

## What happens once your work is accepted and approved for publication?

You've been accepted? CONGRATULATIONS!! Pat yourself on the back and throw a party. After the celebrations are over there are a few things, you can expect to come your way and a couple of contracts to sign.

Someone from the editorial team will be in touch with you once your piece has been accepted. You need to be open to possible edits. We will do our best to let all the submissions stand as they are written, but there could be a need for us to make suggestions. If the author is not open to any edits or rewrites, then it will be up to the discretion of the editorial team if the piece is kept in the publication.

You will need to sign two contracts. One is with SIMA and the other with the distribution service used by the anthology.



### **ROYALTIES?**

Co-Author agrees to waive royalty rights to be in the anthology book with multiple authors. Royalty funds received by SIMA are collected for the purpose of further global expansion of She Inspires Me Awards and other non-profits of choice.

### **RIGHTS**

Co-Author owns the right to their chapter and can repurpose their content anywhere
